Most pharmacies can help you with seven common conditions without needing a GP appointment:

- <u>Sinusitis</u> (adults and children aged 12 years and over).
- Sore Throat (adults and children aged 5 years and over.
- <u>Earache</u> (children and young adults aged 1 year to 17 years).
- Infected insect bite (adults and children aged 1 year and over).
- Impetigo (adults and children aged 1 year and over).
- <u>Shingles</u> (adults aged 18 years and over)
- <u>Urinary tract infection</u> (women aged 16-64 years).
